- 3. All Federal and State firearms laws and regulations apply. The winner must pass any and all legally required background checks to claim a firearm. Sheboygan Rifle and Pistol Club will pay the fee for conducting the background check(s).
- 4. You must be 18yo to enter the raffle. The winner also must be 18yo to claim a rifle or 21yo for a handgun.
- 5. If the value of your prize is over \$600 we may have to report you as a winner to the IRS with your social security number. They will charge you taxes on the value, which you will have to pay. If you don't want to give us the information we need, you cannot get the prize.
- 6. The drawing will be held at 7 pm on December 17,2020 at the SR&PC Clubhouse, W765 Rowe Rd Sheboygan, WI 53083. The drawing is open to the public, but the winner need not be present to win.
- 7. Firearms will be awarded in the order listed on the ticket.
- 8. We will notify winners promptly. Winners have until March 1, 2021 to claim his/her firearm or cash prize. Failure to do so will result in prize forfeiture.
